Vinification

Manually harvested Grapes, into 12kg crates and carefully selected on a choosing table. Fermentation occurs in the mill and vats at a controlled temperature, with several pressings throughout the process. Partial staging for 9 months in French oak barrels.

Tasting Notes

The Monte da Peceguina Red 2024 boasts a deep purple colour and an expressive nose, with prominent notes of red and wild berries complemented by subtle floral hints and oak nuances. The fruity profile is maintained on the palate, resulting in a well-structured wine that is balanced by fresh acidity and ripe tannins. This Monte da Peceguina Red has good ageing potential and is versatile at the table, set to evolve beautifully in the bottle.
